## **Book Parts Identification**

## Today's Standard

K.RI.5 - Identify the front cover, back cover, and title page of a book.

Cues	Notes
What is the front cover?	The front cover is the first page of the book and usually has the title and author.
What is the back cover?	The back cover is the last page of the book and often has a summary or
What is the title page?	The back cover is the last page of the book and often has a summary or reviews.
Why are these parts important?	The title page is inside the book and lists the title, author, and sometimes the publisher.
How can we identify these parts?	These parts help us know what the book is about and who created it.
	We can identify these parts by looking for the title, author, and other distinguishing features.
