What are key details?	Key details are important parts of the story such as characters, settings, and events.
Why is asking questions important?	Asking questions helps us understand the story better and think more deeply about it.

What should we notice in a	
story?	We should notice characters, settings, major events, and any interesting or surprising parts of the story.
