What are characters?	Characters are the people or animals in a story.
What is a setting?	The setting is where the story takes place.
What are major events?	Major events are the important things that happen in the story.
How can we identify characters?	We can identify characters by looking at who is in the story.
How can we identify settings?	We can identify settings by looking at where the story happens.

Understanding characters, settings, and major events in a story helps us follow and enjoy the story better. We use clues from the story to identify these elements.
