Cues	Notes
Author	Author: Writes the text of the story.
Illustrator	Illustrator: Creates the pictures for the story.
Roles in storytelling	Roles in storytelling: Both contribute to how the story is told and understood.
Differences between author and illustrator	Differences: Author focuses on words, Illustrator focuses on images.
