Cues	Notes
What is the purpose of visual aids?	Visual aids help add detail and clarity to verbal descriptions.
How can drawings enhance descriptions?	Drawings can make stories more engaging and easier to understand. Misconception: Drawings need to be perfect.
What are common misconceptions?	Intervention: Focus on the message, not the artistic quality. Misconception: Visual aids are only for art projects.
How can we address these misconceptions?	Intervention: Show examples of visual aids in different contexts.
What skills will students develop next?	Next skills: Using charts and diagrams to support descriptions.

Summary

Visual aids enhance verbal descriptions by adding detail and clarity. Common misconceptions include thinking that drawings need to be perfect and that visual aids are only for art projects. Address these by focusing on the message and showing various uses of visual aids. Future skills include using charts and diagrams.
