What is K.W.2?	K.W.2 involves using drawing, dictating, and writing to create informative texts.
Why combine drawing, dictating, and writing?	Combining these methods helps students express ideas clearly and supports their writing development.
What are common misconceptions?	Common misconceptions include thinking drawing alone is sufficient and fearing imperfect writing.
How to address misconceptions?	Address misconceptions by modeling writing with drawings and emphasizing effort over perfection.
