Cues	Notes
What is shared research?	Shared research involves working together to explore topics and create projects.
Why is it important?	It helps students learn to collaborate and value different perspectives.
How do we express opinions?	
What are some activities?	Students express opinions by discussing their thoughts and feelings about what they've read.
What misconceptions might arise?	Activities include reading books, discussing them, and creating class projects.
	Misconceptions include thinking opinions don't matter and that research is only about reading.
