Common Stumbling Blocks

Sometimes, kids think they only need to ask questions, but they also need to answer them. Another mistake is thinking that every detail is important. Only key details help us understand the main idea.

Help Me

When we read, we look for important details that help us understand the main idea. For example, if we read about a trip to the zoo, key details might be which animals we saw and what they did. Asking and answering questions about these details helps us remember and understand the story better.
