# Character Responses to Events

### Today's Standard

2.RL.3 - Describe how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges.

## Real-World Applications for this Standard

Discuss how a character in a favorite book reacts to a surprise.; Compare how different characters handle a problem in a story.; Relate a character's response to a personal experience of overcoming a challenge.; Create a role-play scenario where students act out different character responses.; Analyze a character's behavior in a movie or TV show.

## Today I Learned

Today we learned about how characters in a story respond to big events and challenges. This helps us understand the story and the characters better.

### **Common Stumbling Blocks**

Sometimes kids think that all characters respond the same way to events, but that's not true. Another thing they might think is that a character's response is always the best way, which isn't always right.

- What did the character do when something surprising happened?
- How did the character feel when they faced a problem?
- Can you think of a different way the character could have responded?
- What was the big event in the story?
- Why did the character act the way they did?

## Help Me

Understanding how characters respond to events in stories helps us see how they think and feel. For example, if a character faces a big challenge, like moving to a new school, we can see how they handle it and learn from their experience.
