# Respectful Discussion Rules

## Today's Standard

2.SL.1a - Follow agreed-upon rules for discussions (e.g., gaining the floor in respectful ways, listening to others with care, speaking one at a time about the topics and texts under discussion).

### Real-World Applications for this Standard

Classroom discussions following rules; Group projects where turn-taking is essential; Family conversations during dinner; Sports team meetings; Community events or town hall meetings
