Today's Standard

2.SL.5 - Create audio recordings of stories or poems; add drawings or other visual displays to stories or recounts of experiences when appropriate to clarify ideas, thoughts, and feelings.

Real-World Applications for this Standard

Recording a story and adding sound effects.; Creating a podcast episode about a personal experience.; Adding illustrations to a recorded poem.; Making a multimedia presentation of a favorite book.
