# Fractions on a Number Line

## Today's Standard

3.NF.A2b - Represent a fraction a/b on a number line diagram by marking off a lengths 1/b from 0. Recognize that the resulting interval has size a/b and that its endpoint locates the number a/b on the number line.

# Real-World Applications for this Standard

Dividing a pizza into equal slices and identifying each slice on a number line.; Measuring lengths of ribbon for crafts and placing them on a number line.; Splitting a chocolate bar into equal pieces and marking the pieces on a number line.

Today, we learned how to place fractions on a number line. We marked off equal parts from zero to show where each fraction belongs.

## **Common Stumbling Blocks**

Sometimes, kids think that the size of the space between numbers doesn't matter, but it does! Each fraction has its own spot. Also, fractions are not just parts of things; they are numbers too!
