

# **Context Clues for Word Meaning**

### Today I Learned

Today, we learned how to use context clues to figure out the meaning of new words. Context clues are hints in the text that help us understand what a word means.

### **Common Stumbling Blocks**

Some kids might think context clues always give a direct definition, but that's not true. Sometimes, you have to use other words in the sentence to guess the meaning. Another tricky part is that not all words will have context clues nearby, so it's okay to look up the word or ask for help.

## Help Me

When you read and find a word you don't know, look at the other words in the sentence to help you understand it. This is called using context clues. For example, if you read, 'The bright, sunny day made everyone happy,' the words 'bright' and 'sunny' help you know that the day was nice.
