# **Context Clues for Word Meaning**

## Today's Standard

7.L.4a - Use context (e.g., the overall meaning of a sentence or paragraph; a word's position or function in a sentence) as a clue to the meaning of a word or phrase.

Today, we learned how to use context clues to figure out the meaning of new words. Context clues are hints in the sentence or paragraph that help us understand what a word means.

## Common Stumbling Blocks

Sometimes, kids think that the hints are always in the same sentence, but they can be in other sentences too. Also, not every word has a clear hint, so we might need to look up words or break them down into parts.

Context clues help us understand new words by looking at the other words around them. For example, if you don't know what 'gargantuan' means, but the sentence says 'The gargantuan pizza was bigger than the table,' you can guess it means very big.
