Today's Standard

K.CC.A2 - Count forward beginning from a given number within the known sequence (instead of having to begin at 1).

Real-World Applications for this Standard

Counting steps while walking; Counting objects in a line; Counting days on a calendar; Counting items while shopping; Counting toys during playtime
