### Today's Standard

## Real-World Applications for this Standard

Reading street signs and store names; Identifying letters in books and magazines; Spelling their own name and friends' names; Playing alphabet games with blocks or cards; Using letters to write simple words

### Today I Learned

### **Common Stumbling Blocks**

Kids might mix up letters that look alike, like 'b' and 'd'. They might also think big and small letters are different characters. We can help by using fun games to show the difference.
