Common Stumbling Blocks

Sometimes kids mix up words that look alike. They might also try to sound out every word instead of just knowing it by sight. Practicing with flashcards and games can help.

- Can you find the word 'the' in this book?
- What word is this? (show flashcard with 'is')
- Can you use the word 'my' in a sentence?
- What word do you see on this sign? (show a sign with 'do')
- Can you read this sentence: 'She is my friend.'?
